PARADE CHECK-IN: RCMP parking lot next to Coquitlam City Hall, entrance is off of Burlington, behind City Hall.

ARRIVAL: Please have the person in charge of your entry report to our CHECK-IN TENT to CONFIRM YOUR ARRIVAL and receive your parade position.

POSITION NUMBER: The position number to be placed on the front right hand side of your entree so that the parade judges, spectators and emcee can easily identify you.

GENERAL POLICIES AND PRACTICES

- ❖ The Festival Coquitlam parade officials reserve the right to remove any entrant from the parade either prior to, during assembly, or any time during the parade.
- ❖ Invited dignitaries/guests are responsible for obtaining a suitable car and a sign indicating who is riding in the car.
- ❖ Parade entries will abide by the rules and any instructions issued by the event officials and the RCMP.
- ❖ Judging takes place in the assembly area at 9:00 am. Please allow yourself enough time to set up. If you are not in position by that time you will forfeit consideration.
- ❖ **No material may be thrown, or in any way distributed from your entry that could injure spectators.** Entrants may use accompanying pedestrians to walk along both sides of the parade route distributing items directly to the public and must not cause any delay of the parade. Canvassing and / or asking for donations are strictly prohibited.
- ❖ Parade participants must keep pace with the parade and may not mingle with spectators.
- ❖ Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle or on the person of any participant. Participants suspected of consuming alcohol or illegal substances prior to or during this event are subject to removal from the parade.
- ❖ Entries advocating, opposing, or depicting any political, religious or social issues that in the opinion of the parade organizers do not meet the objectives of the parade will not be allowed.
- ❖ Parade officials will be visible along the route and have the authority to regulate spacing issues should they arise. In the event that you encounter mechanical difficulties, their assistance will be available.

FLOAT SAFETY

- ❖ Float and vehicles must be mechanically sound, provide good visibility and a qualified driver.
- ❖ Participants on the vehicle must use safety restraints / hand holds while it's in motion.
- ❖ Be equipped with a working fire extinguisher (5lb.dry chem.)

WALKING GROUPS

- ❖ Need to be assembled by 9:00 am for judging.
- ❖ Are expected to carry on continuous forward motion throughout the parade.
- ❖ Support vehicles will be judged as a part of the groups.
